Taye's Burgers & Cheesesteaks 1019 & 315 Armour Rd, North Kansas City, MO 64116

Whether it's the standard single, double or triple patty, Taye's has been slingin it's own style of classic burgers since 2014 and recently has opened its extension Taye's Cheesesteaks just a few blocks down Armour Road.

Hawg Jaw BBQ 900 Swift St, North Kansas City, MO 64116
